Rules:

1. Entries will be received from 3:00 to 8:00 pm Mon., August 7 at the Attala County Coliseum.
2. Exhibits will be open to the public from 5:00 to 9:00 pm Wed. & Thurs., August 9 & 10, and from 2:00 to 6:00 pm on Friday, August 11, 2017.
3. Exhibits must be removed between 6:00 and 6:30 pm on Friday, August 11, 2017.
4. Ribbons will be given on three divisions: Adult Male, Adult Female and Youth.

Qualifications:

1. Exhibits must be fish or game harvested by the exhibitor in any year prior to the fair that has not previously won.
2. No prize winning exhibit previously shown at the Central Mississippi Fair Fin, Horn, & Feather shows may be exhibited.

3. All exhibits must be labeled with exhibitor's name, address and phone number.
4. Exhibitors may have as many as two entries in each class.
5. Exhibits of fish or game must represent a species native to the Central Mississippi area and must be regarded as a game species. Exception will be made for taxidermists for display only.
6. Entrants in the youth division must be age 18 or younger.
7. Entrants in the adult division must be age 19 or over.

AWARDS:

Best in Show: (adult and youth) given in each class (deer, fish, turkey). It will receive a rosette and \$10.00 cash award.

Blue, Red, White, and Yellow ribbons will be awarded to adult and youth classes in each of the lots. Cashawards are: \$10.00 – Best in Show.

26. CLASS - DEER RACKS

Judging will be based on Boone & Crockett system. Racks only and shoulder mounts will be treated alike.

27. CLASS - FISH

Judging will be based on weight only.
